A target population of:

Rural areas, fatherhood, healthy marriages, welfare-to-work, at-risk families, elders in need, addictions, homelessness, prisoner re-entry, and children of prisoners.

If you answered 'Yes' to these questions, you are eligible to submit a RFP.
